

Department of Commerce – Functional Mandates

This department's main functional mandate is to support the economic health of the nation in alignment with the values and principals stated in the Constitution. As the core of the economy lies with Cottage and Small Business industries, activities of this department will focus its efforts toward their sustainability and evolvement by:

- Guiding tax funded research and development investments that support the production of goods and services which harmonize with local and circular economic principals.
- Communicating production targets that meet internal demand and resilience reserves of Survival and Comfort products to industry associations.
- Formulating and establishing trade arrangements that promote the importation of Comfort and Luxury products other Nations are better suited to produce due to their unique ecosystems and cultures. Ensuring priority Nation status is extended to those who rank highest in Citizen Happiness and Planet Friendliness indexes or are diligent in their efforts to improve these rankings. Emphasizing the development of import and export trade relations with those Nations located in closest geographic proximity. Managing trade volumes to affect a balance of monetary value between imports and exports.

Oversight of the Community Profit Sharing and National Resilience Reserves Programs in regard to fair and equitable distribution is also a key responsibility of this department.

Ensuring adherence to Market Price Regulations by all organizations within the Nation is a critical component of the social agreement this department has with the Citizenry. Maintaining the affordability and availability of Survival and Comfort products that support the happiness of its citizens, sustain the health of the planet, and bolster the National GDP is paramount for the successful operation of this department.
